2. This office letter in C.No.R2/860/2019, dated 25.11.2019 addressed to the DGP, Tamil Nadu, Chennai-4.

Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board has published an Advertisement in the dailies on 08.03.2019 for conducting recruitment for the post of Sub-Inspector of Police for the year 2019.

2) It is informed that the board has decided to conduct the written examinations for departmental candidates on 11.01.2020 (Saturday) and general candidates on 12.01.2020 (Sunday) at Chennai city and 31 Districts.

3) It is informed that suitable closed venues preferably schools or colleges with adequate number of tables and chairs in your City /District have to be identified, not less than 500 candidates allotted in each venue. The guidelines for identification of venues are enclosed along with model seating arrangement in Annexures-II & III.

4) The Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai Police, Chennai City and Superintendents of Police in Districts are requested to constitute "Venue Identification Teams" headed by officers of the rank of ADSP/AC for identification of venues as per the guidelines enclosed. The Commissioners of Police, Coimbatore, Thiruppur, Salem, Trichy, Madurai and Tirunelveli are requested to nominate an officer in Commissionerates to assist the concerned SPs in Districts in venue identification.

5) The exercise of identification of venues should be conducted with utmost urgency and thoroughness. The details of approximate number of candidates for the

32 centres are furnished in Annexure.I for departmental candidates and general candidates. However, the exact number of candidates for the examinations will be intimated soon.

6) It is requested that the complete list of selected venues along with the Venue Inspection Report (Annexure.IV) may be sent to TNUSRB on or before 12.12.2019 positively as the venues have to be incorporated in the hall tickets.
