It will improve business management skills of women. It is estimated that the GDP of the country will grow between 12% and 25% in the next five years by bringing in more women.

The implementation of Phase-I of RuPay cards in Bhutan has enabled visitors from India to access ATMs and Point of Sale (PoS) terminals across Bhutan.
- ✓ Phase-II will now allow Bhutanese card holders to access RuPay network in India. India and Bhutan share a special partnership, anchored in mutual understanding and respect, reinforced by a shared cultural heritage and strong people to people links.

Devotees from across the country observe fast, offer prayers to the Sun God. It is one of the biggest festivals celebrated in the states and in some parts of the neighbouring country, Nepal.

- ✓ The Tungabhadra Pushkaralu is a 12-day festival celebrated in the state of Andhra Pradesh, to honour the Tungabhadra river. It commenced on November 20, this year.
- ✓ Tungabhadra river starts from the state of Karnataka and continues to flow through two neighbouring states – Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. 12 major rivers across the country are worshipped by a festival named 'Pushkaralu or Pushkaram'.

- ✓ The trilateral exercise called 'SITEMEX-20' between the navies of India, Singapore and Thailand was recently completed. The exercise took place in the Andaman Sea. The Indian Navy-owned submarine INS Kamortha and the missile carrier Karmuk took part in the exercise.
- ✓ The first SITEMEX training took place in Port Blair last year. The exercise is aimed at strengthening mutual trust between the navies of Singapore and Thailand, building common understanding and adopting the best practices needed to improve maritime security. This year's exercise was led by the Singapore Navy.

- ✓ The 30<sup>th</sup> edition of India–Thailand Coordinated Patrol (Indo–Thai CORPAT) between the Indian Navy and the Royal Thai Navy is conducted from 18 – 20 November 2020. Indian Naval Ship (INS) Karmuk, an indigenously built Missile Corvette and His Majesty’s Thailand Ship (HTMS) Kraburi, a Chao Phraya Class Frigate along with Dornier Maritime Patrol Aircraft from both the navies are participating in the CORPAT.
- ✓ As part of Government of India’s vision of SAGAR (Security and Growth for All in the Region), the Indian Navy has been involved in assisting countries in the Indian Ocean Region with EEZ Surveillance, Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR), and other capacity building and capability–enhancement activities, on their request. To reinforce maritime links, the two navies have been carrying out CORPAT along their International Maritime Boundary Line twice a year since 2005, with the aim of keeping this vital part of the Indian Ocean safe and secure for commercial shipping and international trade.

- ✓ The Government of India will also award best Organisations for 2019–20 [Tamil Nadu Fisheries Development Corporation Ltd. (for Marine); Telangana State Fishermen Cooperative societies Federation Ltd (for Inland), and Assam Apex Cooperative Fish Marketing and Processing Federation Ltd. (for Hilly region)]; Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh as best Marine District; Kalahandi, Odisha as best Inland District; Nagaon, Assam as Best Hilly and NE District.
