- ✓ GDP at Constant Prices in Q2 2021–22 is estimated at ₹35.73 lakh crore, as against ₹32.97 lakh crore in Q2 2020–21, with a growth of 8.4 percent as compared to 7.4 percent contraction in Q2 2020–21.
