Agricultural Census is the main source of information on the number and area of operational holdings, their size, class—wise distribution, land use, tenancy and cropping pattern, etc.

The MH–60R is the most advanced marine multi–mission helicopter which is in use currently.







The Indian Broadcasting Company ltd (IBC) was taken over by the British and transformed into All India Radio (AIR) in 1936.

✓ According to NITI Aayog's India Innovation Index 2021, India's gross expenditure on research and development (R&D) is one of the lowest in the world, with just USD 43 per capita.

✓ It said that India needs to boost this expenditure and at least be on a par with its BRICS or ASEAN counterparts like Russia (USD 285) and Brazil (USD 173). In India, the government spends more than 55% on R&D and private sector is to be encouraged to take up research.




