




The NDCs are to be communicated to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). India last submitted its NDC in the year 2015. India has committed to reduce the emissions intensity of its GDP by 45% by 2030 and achieving 50% cumulative electric power installed capacity from non–fossil fuel–based energy resources by 2030.



- ✓ The initial ten thousand startups were recognized in 808 days, while the latest ten thousand were achieved in only 156 days.

✓ Varuna, India's first drone that can carry human pay-load has a range of 25 km. The passenger drone can carry 130 kg payload and has 25-33 minutes of flight time. Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently watched the demonstration of India's first passenger drone, Varuna. 'Varuna' drone has been designed and developed by a startup 'Sagar Defence Engineering'.
